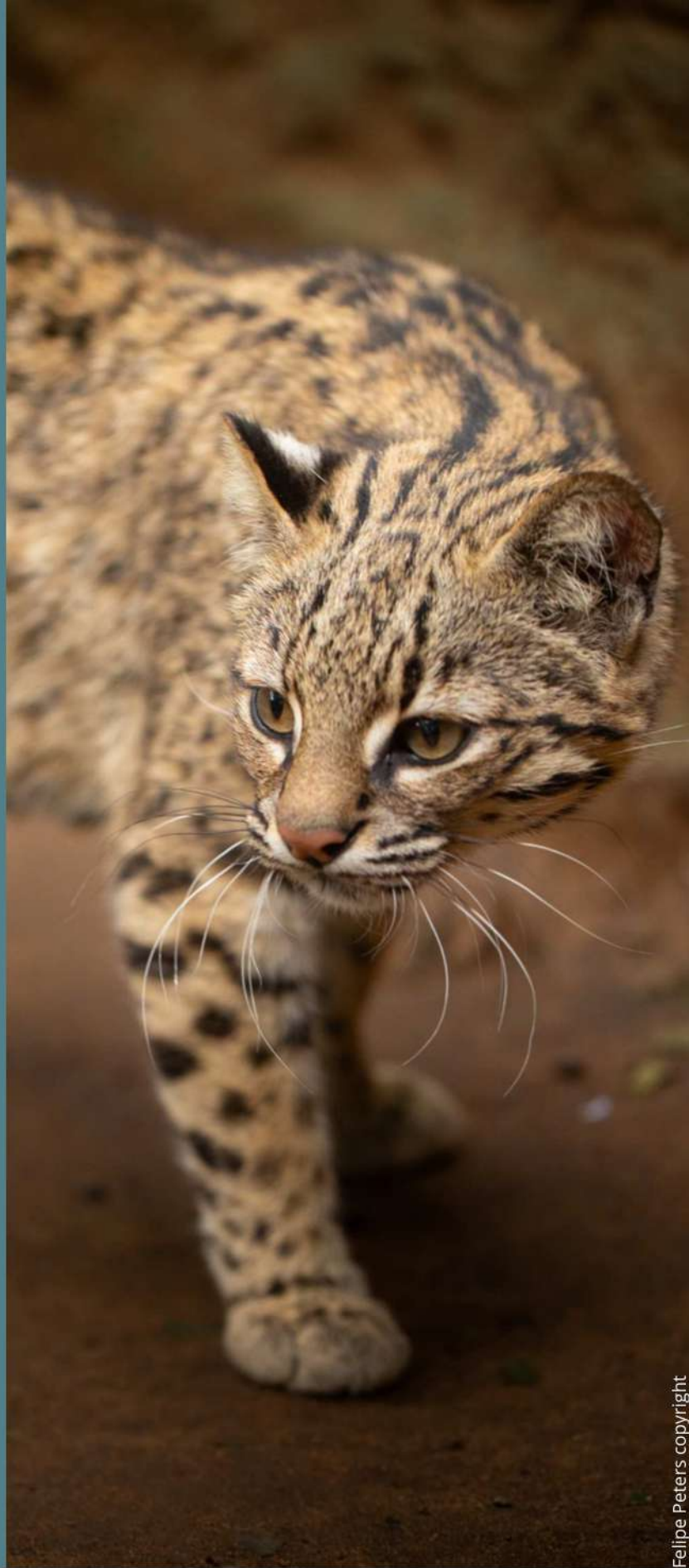

# MEET THE TEAM

PEOPLE BEHIND THE GCWG



GCWG is a network of conservationists, researchers and enthusiasts. We aim to help the survival of Geoffroy's cat wild populations and other sympatric small wild cats, their natural habitats across Geoffroy's cat entire distribution range.

We have more than 40 members spread across the six countries where this species lives.



# OUR STRATEGY

---



People need to know the species, its biology and threats to conservation to support our efforts. We will use social media to raise public awareness and, at the same time, carry out environmental education campaigns in local communities.

We are now collectively identifying the local factors that threaten the wildcat, in order to prioritize actions. Each member's project has its own objectives and aims to answer different questions related to the species. However, all of the projects in our working group involve the conservation of the species among its objectives, and the GCWG will build on these pre-existing projects. We are supporting conservation actions such as:

- Awareness programs with children and using social media to reduce future threats;
  - Surveys and monitoring of wildcat populations in different regions of their distribution;
  - Alignment and application of government policies (local, regional and national);
  - Partnerships and financing for existing rescue, rehabilitation and release centers;
  - Actions to reduce pedestrian accidents (speed reducer, fences, outdoors, etc.).
  - Reduction of conflicts
  - Finally, when necessary, we will support research aimed at improving our understanding of the ecological needs of this wild cat.

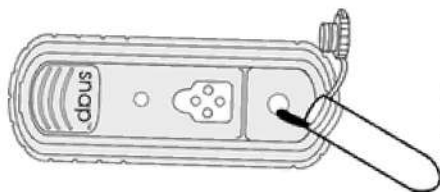

**In areas where our projects are implemented, cats and dogs are often found in habitats of wild cats. This creates a significant risk of disease transmission between domestic and wild animals.**

To take action in mitigating zoonotic risks, more than 646 domestic dogs and 142 cats were vaccinated against rabies, distemper, and other transmissible diseases, in addition to being dewormed.

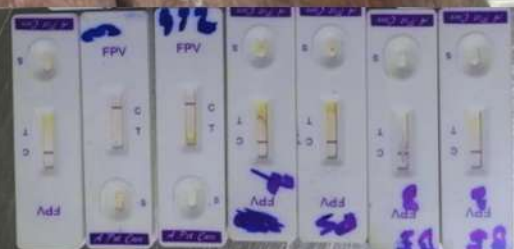

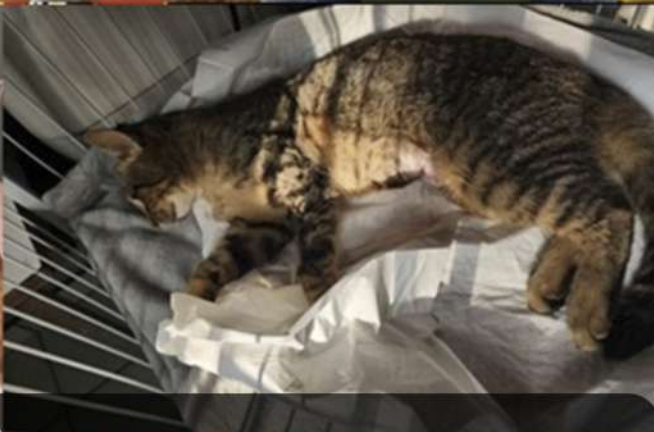

# GLOBAL INICIATIVE OF ACTIONS TO MITIGATE ROADKILLS





In June 2023, the GCWG officially launched the Global Initiative of Actions to Mitigate Roadkills (GIAMR) in collaboration with the amazing initiative **#lentoporlafaua** from ConGarra. These enormous initiatives are now being carried out in six countries: Bolivia, Paraguay, Argentina, Brazil, Uruguay, and Chile. We seek to protect small cats and prevent roadkill through joint, planned activities!

We also strategically place signs along roadways, they serve as important reminders to drivers to slow down and keep an eye out for animals crossing the road. This simple but effective approach helps to lower the likelihood of accidents with wild animals and save lives.

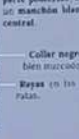

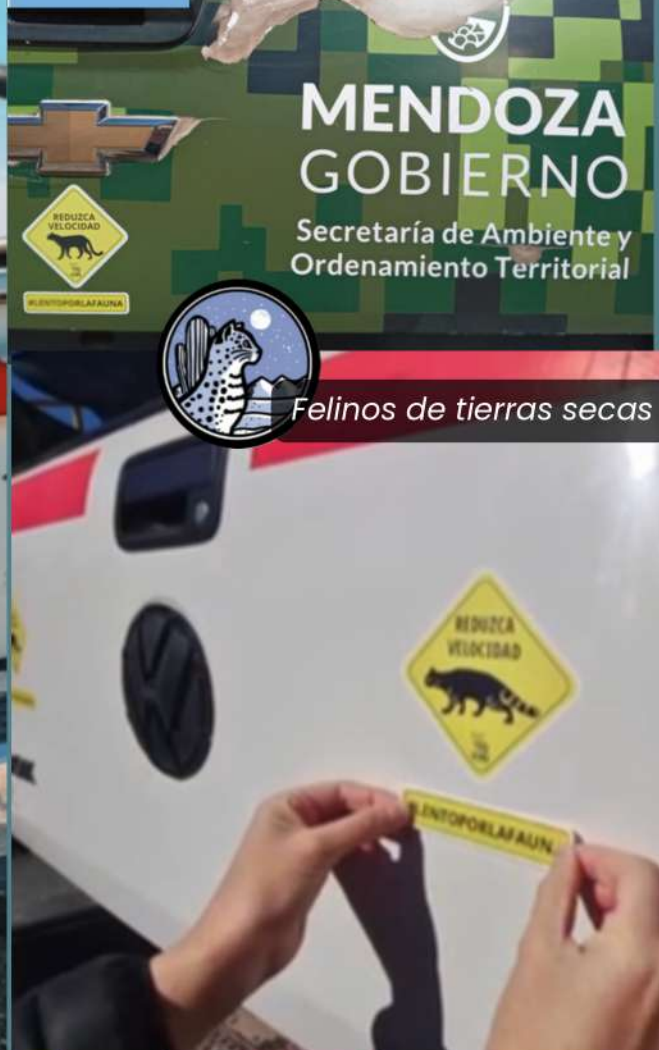

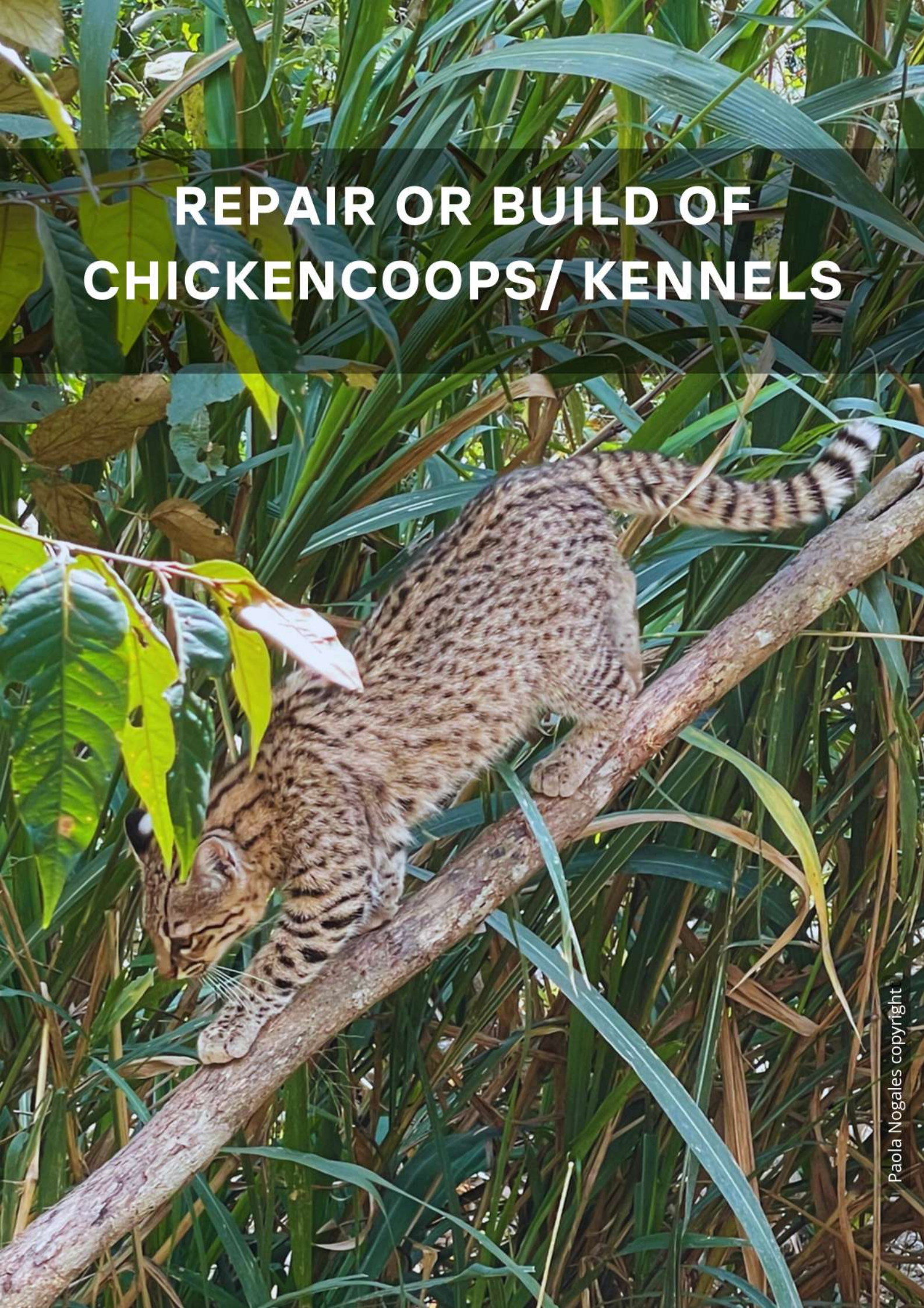

# REPAIR OR BUILD OF CHICKENCOOPS/ KENNELS







This smart Geoffroy's cat took advantage of the wire mesh in the chicken coop to hunt chickens.

To prevent further chicken losses and promote coexistence, the **Conservación Felinos Uruguay project** reinforced the chicken coop with wire mesh featuring smaller netting. This improvement ensures the cat can no longer get into the chicken coop.

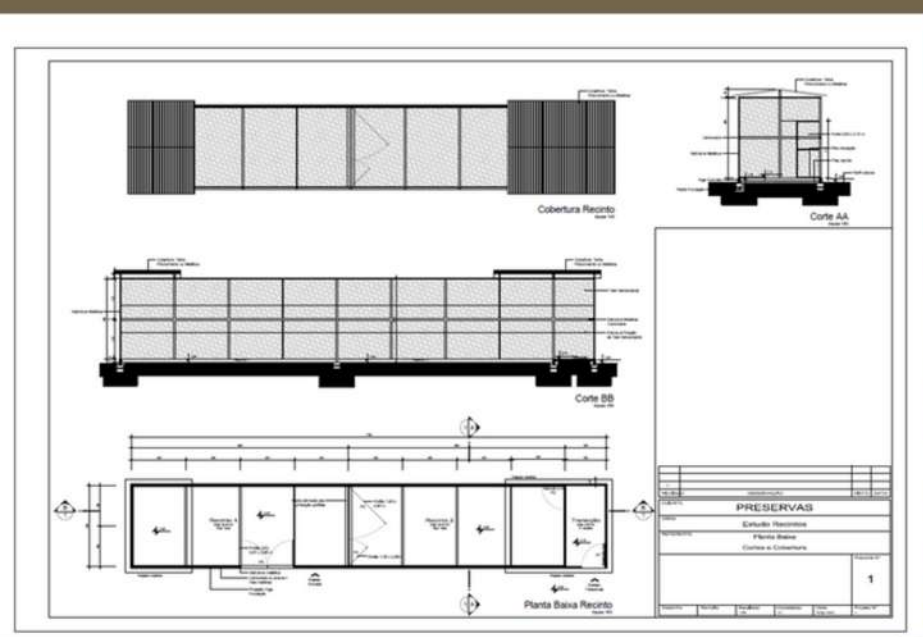

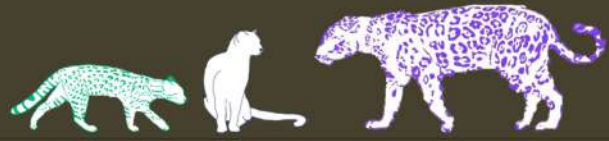

**Bichos do Mar de Dentro** is an association of craftswomen that produces sustainable products driven by the desire to showcase some of the wildlife of southernmost Brazil. Therefore, in partnership with Felinos do Pampa/ GCWG, we have developed products focusing on native small wild cats to 'spread the word' about these amazing species!





# SMALL CATS RESCUE







In 2024, Southern Brazil was severely affected by floods, people lost their houses, and wild animals were affected by this natural disaster!





GCWG with Felinos do pampa, and an amazing group of volunteers and heroes, taked action and saved animals, domestic and wild.



More than 11,000 domestic and wild animals were rescued in Rio Grande do Sul, and many with the support of GCWG.





**GCWG provided medications, surgical materials, and animal restraint materials, as well as we are donating the construction of a new enclosure for rehabilitation.**





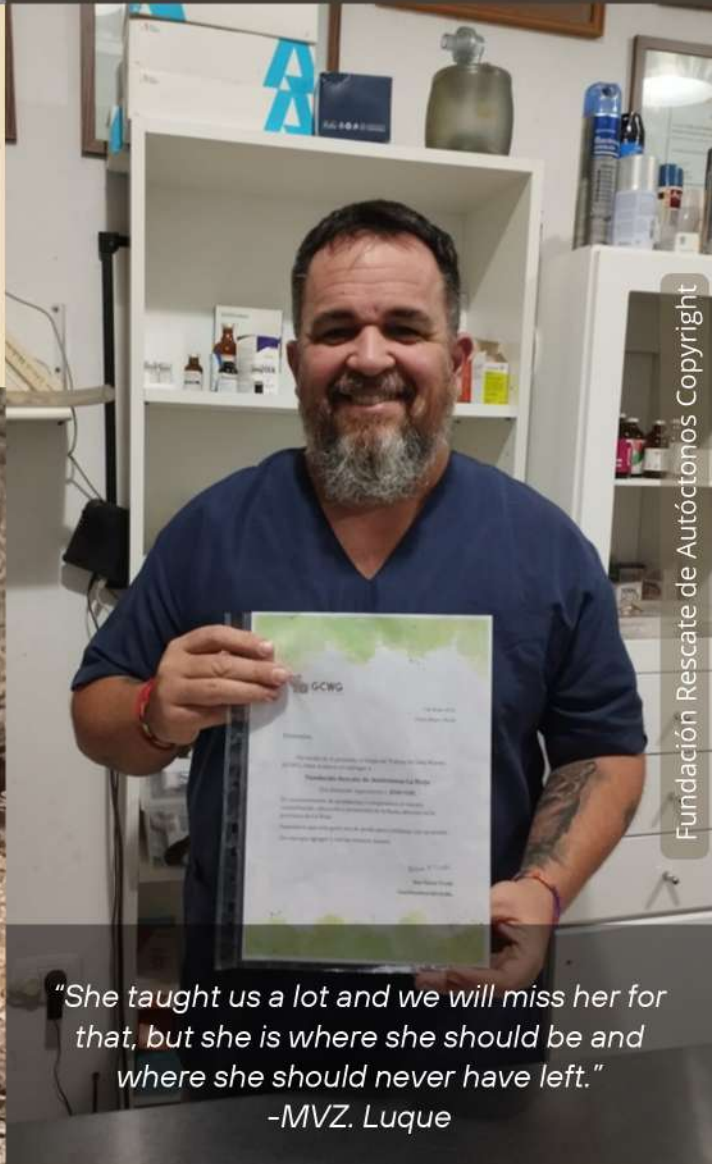

In June, Uruguay Foto Trampeo was contacted by a person who had two cubs of Geoffroy's cats at his home.

He explained that following a flood, he saw a "raft" carrying three felines. Sadly, one had already passed away, and the other two were in imminent danger.

Acting quickly, he rescued the cats. A few days later, he realized that these were not ordinary domestic cats but wild Geoffroy's cats.



He immediately reached out to Uruguay Foto Trampeo for assistance. In coordination with the Ministry of the Environment, the kittens were transferred to the "Estación de Cría de Fauna Autóctona", where they are now undergoing rehabilitation.







In Bolivia, our partners at Senda Verde rescued three ocelots in 2024, victims of wildlife trafficking and human cruelty.

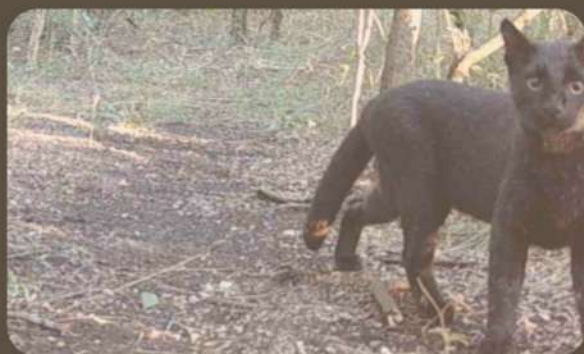

**Conservación felinos Uruguay**, is monitoring species in the protected area of Santa Lucía Wetlands and a private establishment.

In Santa Lucia, the only wild cat present is the geoffroy's cat, while in the private establishment that is the typical Uruguayan country side, and the geoffroy's cat coexist with the pampas cat.

**La Esmeralda Protected Natural Area** is a private initiative located in the central-eastern region of Entre Ríos Province, Argentina. It safeguards well-preserved remnants of native forests in an area heavily impacted by habitat fragmentation, making it a critical refuge for local biodiversity, especially our cat *Leopardus geoffroyi*.

Through camera traps, the team monitors the individuals living in the reserve, yielding incredible findings year after year. Notably, in 2024, they recorded melanistic Geoffroy's cat!

organisation, are working with camera trap in several localities and use the material to promote love and care for wildlife in general and felids in particular.



**Mamíferos SO Bonaerense** project set up camera traps at 4 sites in Partido Villarino, near the protected Reserva Provincial Chapalco, and at 32 sites in Partido Patagones, to monitor carnivore populations in Buenos Aires province.

This extensive monitoring effort is crucial for understanding the dynamics of local wildlife and informing conservation strategies.

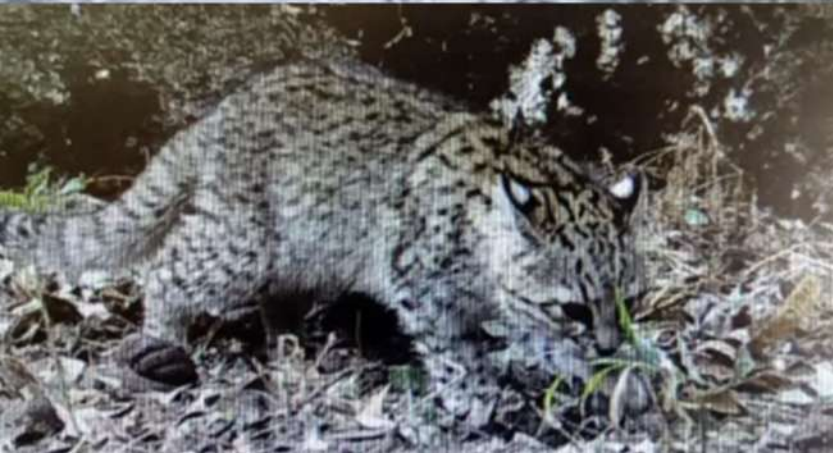
The **Gatos Bravos** project has deployed 15 camera traps in the Laguna Brava provincial reserve in La Rioja, to record Geoffroy's cat and other native carnivores. The exciting results of this monitoring effort will be shared in March 2025!

**The Andean Carnivore Conservation Program,** based in Tarija, southern Bolivia, is dedicated to protecting the unique inter-Andean dry forest ecosystem, ensuring its conservation, benefits both wildlife and the local communities that rely on it.

Through ongoing camera trap monitoring, the program studies the population and behavior of native carnivores, including Geoffroy's cat. By utilising this information, the project actively promotes conservation efforts and works to protect this fragile habitat.

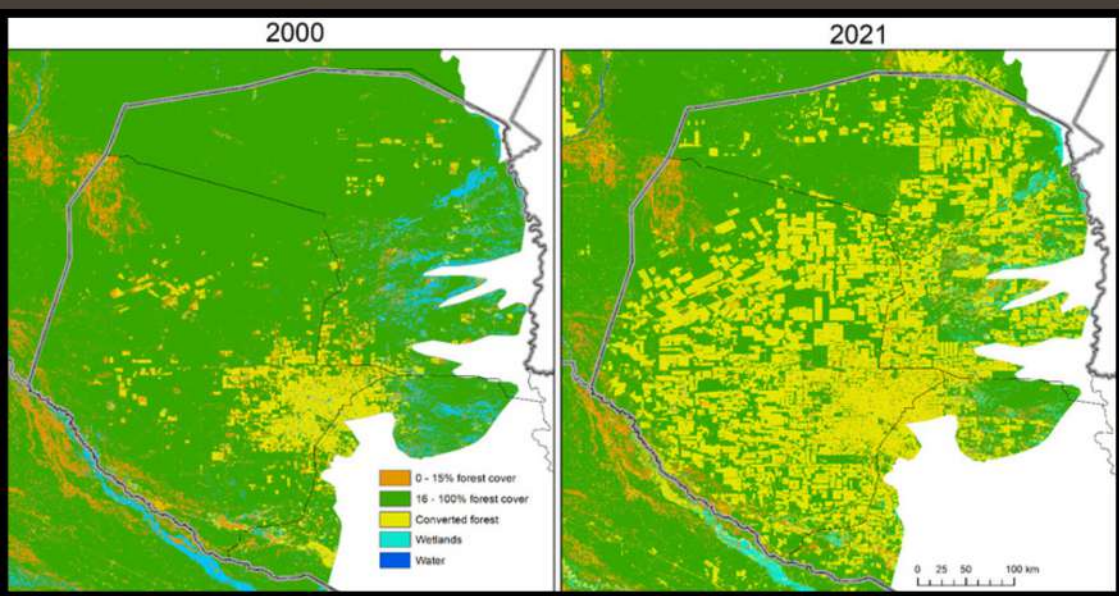

Marianella Velilla and the team from **Asociación Guyra Paraguay** are assessing the impact of deforestation on the medium and large mammal community in the Paraguayan Chaco over the years, including Geoffroy's cat. In addition to their research, they are implementing conservation measures to protect this elusive feline in this rapidly changing and unique landscape.





**The Felinos de Tierras Secas project** is using camera trapping to investigate how environmental factors and human activities influence the abundance and local distribution of small wild felids in the region. In 2024, the project expanded to include a new study site in the western-central part of Mendoza province, Argentina. In this new location, 18 additional monitoring sites have been established to track small wild cats and examine their interactions with local communities.

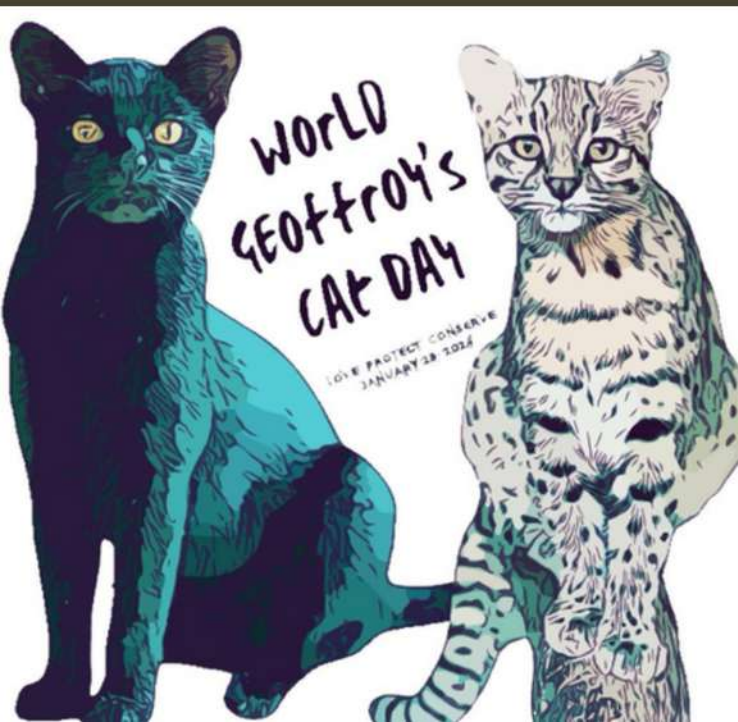
